## OUR SCHEDULE OF WORKS

## **INITIAL ENQUIRY & QUOTE STAGE**

Once you have made contact with our office and we have discussed your requirements, it may be beneficial for us to come out to meet you, survey the site of the proposed install and discuss your preferences. From here we can put together a quote for your consideration.

## PLANNING STAGE

After you have read through our quote proposal and have signed to agree terms, a member of the team will be in touch to discuss your upcoming install.

We will then work closely with you to finalise a design, taking into consideration your preferences and requirements. We will also advise on what works will be required in advance such as groundworks and footings to allow for the installation of your new structure.

Following these discussions, HB Oak Frames will present to you a finished plan for your approval which will require a signature. We are always happy to help with any design requirements that you may have and will try our best to incorporate these. Once approved, your oak will be ordered and cut to spec in the yard.

## **INSTALL STAGE**

An install date will be discussed and agreed with you along with an expected duration of works. We will be in touch before this date to ensure that any groundworks (if not provided by HB Oak Frames) have been completed prior, and are ready for us to begin works.

On install day, the oak will arrive on a lorry with the HB Oak Frames install team in attendance and work on your new install will begin. The team on site will be able to answer any questions that you may have regarding the build.

## **COMPLETION STAGE**

Nearing the end of completion, our Install Team will walk you through the job and make sure you are happy with the work carried out. At this point any snagging issues can be identified and rectified on site.

### MAINTENANCE STAGE

Following your install, you may have questions regarding the preservation of your oak frame.

Obviously oak and timber are natural materials which age with time and will require regular maintenance to be carried out by yourself to keep the building looking as good as it was when first erected.
